DO NOT use this equipment unless you have been trained and assessed to a competent level in its sate use and operation, and have been given permission to use this



- Before using this TradeQuip Engine Crane Ram ensure it is in sound condition, and good working order.
- Replace or repair damaged parts. Use recommended parts only. Non-authorised parts may be dangerous and will invalidate the warranty.
- Keep this TradeQuip Engine Crane Ram clean for best and safest performance.
- Maintain correct balance and footing. Ensure the floor is not slippery and wear non-slip shoes.
- Ensure all non-essential persons keep a safe distance whilst this TradeQuip Engine Crane Ram is in use.
- Always ensure this TradeQuip Engine Crane Ram and the load is stable.
- DO NOT operate unit if damaged.
- DO NOT allow untrained persons to operate this TradeQuip Engine Crane Ram.
- DO NOT exceed the rated capacity of 8,000kg.

ASSEMBLY, OPERATION, PREVENTITIVE MAINTENANCE

1. FEATURES

This twin piston TradeQuip "Made for the Trade" 8,000kg Long Hydraulic Ram is the ideal replacement jack for use on TradeQuip hydraulic engine cranes. Mounts directly onto the engine crane and features a slow release function while providing a long 630–1135mm lift range. High quality large diameter twin cylinder hydraulic pump unit results in Quick Lift action, lower oil pressure needed to raise the load, which reduces wear and extends service life. 100% factory vertical load tested for reliability and safety. For vertical use only.

Replacement long hydraulic ram. Suitable replacement for TradeQuip 1001 engine crane.

2. BEFORE USE

Prior to each use conduct a visual inspection by checking for abnormal conditions, such as cracked joints and damaged, loose, or missing parts.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Attach the Hydraulic Ram to the crane you are using. Secure the Ram Base Clevis to the crane by inserting a pin (not included) through the holes in the Ram Base Clevis and properly securing it. Slide another pin (not included) through the product and Ram, securing it as well. Make sure the pins diameters are a push fit with just enough clearance so they move freely. The pins should be held in place with appropriate e-clips or hardened cotter pins (neither one included). Note: Only use pins that are intended for supporting this type of Ram, which are capable of supporting 8,000kg, and ensure that the pins are properly secured before use. Note: This Ram is not intended for horizontal use.
- 2. Insert the Handle into the Handle Socket.

RAISING AND LOWERING

- 1. To raise the Hydraulic Ram turn the Release Valve clockwise until the valve is tightly closed. Pump the Handle to extend the Ram. Continue to pump the Handle until the Hydraulic Ram is at the desired length (height).
- 2. To lower the Ram, first verify that the area under the object is clear, then turn the Release Valve counterclockwise. This will release pressure in the Jack and cause the Ram to lower.

Adding Hydraulic Oil

1. Turn the Release Valv counterclockwise until Ram is completely lowered. Remove the Oil Plug from the Oil Chamber. Fill the Oil Chamber with oil. Use a high quality hydraulic jack oil. Note: The capacity of the oil chamber is 17.6 ounces.

Hydraulic System Bleeding Instructions

If the Hydraulic Ram begins to lose power and efficiency, it may be a result of air being trapped in the hydraulic system.

Follow the steps shown below to bleed the air from the hydraulic system.

Caution: Make certain that the Hydraulic Ram is not under load whilst bleeding the system.

- 1. Remove oil chamber's Oil Plug.
- 2. Pump the Handle to raise the Ram to its highest position. Open the Release Valve.
- 3. Release the Handle to lower the Ram. Repeat pumping the Handle a number of times to force the hydraulic oil through the system.
- 4. Top off the oil chamber with hydraulic oil. Tighten the Oil Plug. The bleeding process is now complete.
- 5. Test the Hydraulic Ram to be certain it is working properly. Only proceed after you ensure that it is working properly

4. STORAGE

This TradeQuip Engine Crane Ram should always be stored in a dry location on a level surface. Clean with a clean cloth with a detergent or mild solvent. Ensure the ram cylinder is in the fully retracted position to minimise dust and corrosion.

5. MAINTENANCE

Clean using a clean cloth with a detergent or mild solvent, then inspect the general condition of the Ram. Check for:

- loose hardware,
- misalignment or binding of moving parts,
- cracked, bent, or broken parts, and
- any other condition that may affect its safe operation.

Replace or repair damaged parts using recommended TradeQuip parts only. Non-authorised parts may be dangerous and will invalidate the warranty.

Thoroughly test the Ram for proper operation. If the Ram appears not to be working properly, follow Bleeding instructions on page 4.

Change the hydraulic oil at least once every three years:

a. With the Ram fully retracted, remove the Oil Fill Plug on the side.

b. Tip the Ram to allow the old hydraulic oil to drain out completely, and dispose of the old hydraulic oil in accordance with local regulations.

c. With the Ram upright, completely fill the reservoir with a high quality hydraulic oil (not included) until the oil just begins to run out of the Oil Fill Hole.

d. Then, reinstall the Oil Fill Plug.

Repeat testing the Ram for proper operation. If the Ram appears not to be working properly, repeat Bleeding instructions on page 4.

Finally, clean thoroughly using a clean cloth with a detergent or mild solvent. Then, store the Ram in a safe, dry location.

Always keep this TradeQuip Engine Crane Ram retracted and clean for best and safest performance.

6. SERVICE & REPAIR

Any TradeQuip Engine Crane Ram found damaged in any way, or found to be worn or operates abnormally should be removed from service until repaired by an authorised service agent. Owners and / or operators should be aware that repair of this product may require specialised equipment and knowledge. Only authorised parts, labels and decals shall be used on this equipment. Annual inspection of the engine stand is recommended and can be made by an authorised repair facility to ensure that your equipment is in optimum condition and that the equipment has the correct decals and safety labels specified by the manufacturer.
